






— MMS3003— **ENVIRONMENT - ISSUE AND GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE**



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








LECTURE NOTES


LECTURE 3 - ACT LOCALLY THINK GLOBALLY

LECTURE 9 - POLITICS, SOCIO-ECONOMIC, ENVIRONMENT, AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

This lecture discusses the global commitment to control climate change and pollution problems, how these environmental issues affected the social and economy of the countries. Students are given an opportunity to suggest how to minimize the problem if they act as policy makers.




































