The e-learning sessions took place on August 9 and 10 in the computer lab of Technology Building of Estonian University of Life Sciences. In total, **there were 8 academic hours split across 4 sessions:**

- E-learning session I: "How to create guizzes in Moodle"
- E-learning session II: "Possibilities of using the assignement tool in the Moodle courses"
- E-learning session III: "H5P How to create interactive videos, quizzes and presentations"
- E-learning session IV: "Various digital tools that can be used in teaching"

The training was conducted in English.

The purpose of the training was to introduce, through practical tasks, some of the most used elearning environments and tools that Estonian University of Life Sciences uses in its teaching. The participants had to create and set up a quiz for the Moodle course, which consists of the 4 most common question types and create and set up an assignment tool for the Moodle course, where students download a file uploaded by the lecturer, complete it, and submit the completed file into the assignment tool. The participants also had the opportunity to explore the possibilities of H5P and to practically try out two content types. In the last session, I introduced various digital tools that can be used in the implementation of teaching.

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
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Learning outcomes:

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
