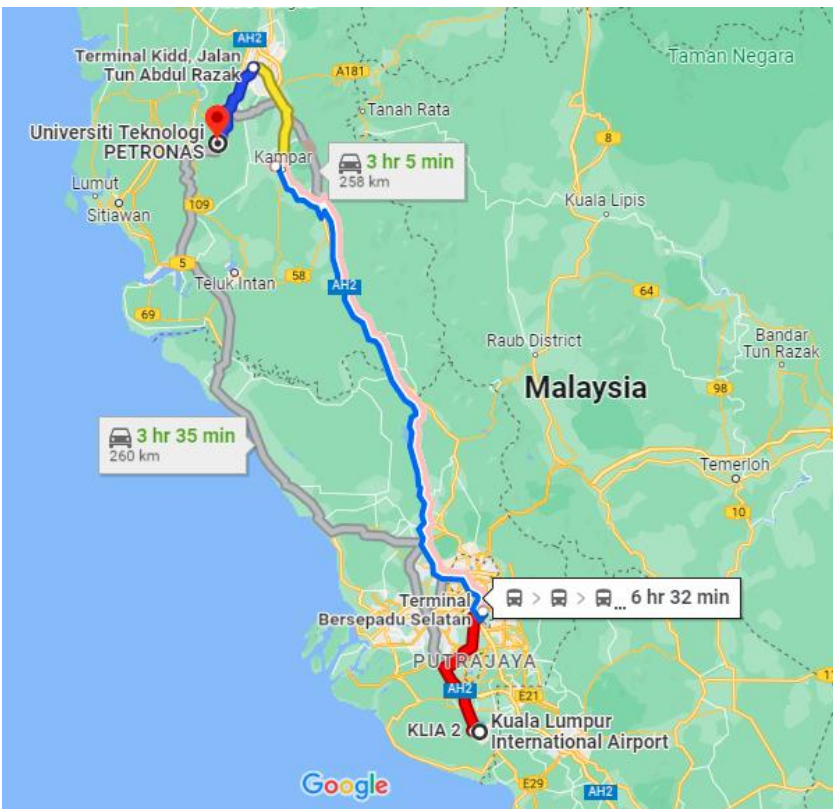

- 35km from Ipoh city centre (approximately 40 minutes by car)
- 35km from Sultan Azlan Shah Airport, Ipoh (approximately 40 minutes by car)

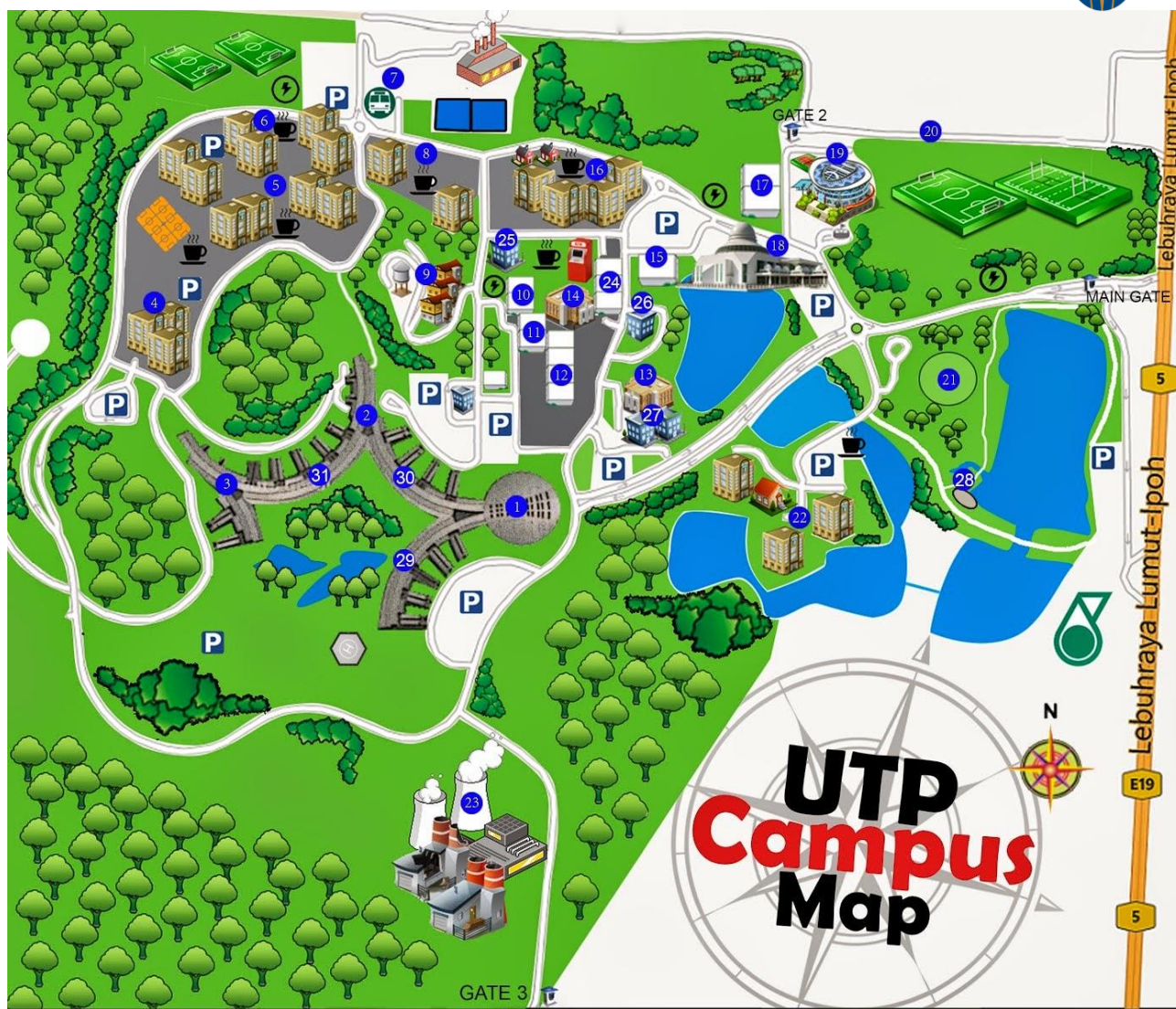

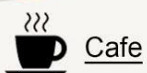

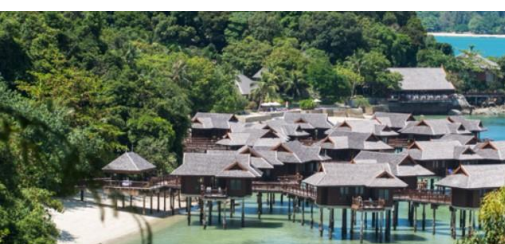

## Internet and Telecommunication Connectivity

+60 is the country code for Malaysia. However, you are not required to dial "0060" when you are making a call with local telephone.

The Malaysian's telecommunication's frequencies are: 2G frequencies at 900 and 1800 MHz band. 3G (UMTS) frequencies are 2100 (Band 1) and 900MHz (Band 8) band while the 4G (LTE) frequencies are mainly 2600MHz (Band 7) and 1800MHz (Band 3). In order for your phone to work in Malaysia, you shall ensure your phone is capable with the network frequencies.

The main telecommunication operators in Malaysia are Maxis, Celcom, Digi, U Mobile and Tune Talk. For tourists to Malaysia, the best and cheapest way is to get a prepaid SIM card which you could make calls and access to internet. Prepaid cards are commonly available at airport, shopping malls or even selected convenient stores, e.g. 7-11, Speed 99 Mart, etc. For details of the prepaid plans, you can refer to:

# TRAVELLING TO MALAYSIA

## Digital Pre-Departure Form

All travelers arriving by air, land or sea into Malaysia are required to complete the Digital Pre-Departure Form (DPDF). The DPDF can be found under the 'Traveler' icon on the MySejahtera application. The DPDF requests details that are considered critical health information. Travelers must have the DPDF completed before check-in to be allowed to board their flight.

Fully vaccinated travelers will be issued with a Digital Traveler Card upon submission of the DPDF.

Partially vaccinated or unvaccinated travelers will be issued with a Digital Home Surveillance Order (HSO) for 5 days. These travelers will be required to quarantine for 5 days upon arrival.
